5. In the case of applications submitted on behalf of a farmer by another (e.g. adviser/breed society etc.) the farmer's permission must be sought prior to submission along with his/her agreement to the information supplied with the application form.
6. Entrants must not have won this award in the three previous years.
7. Applications must be received by QMS by 5pm on Friday 6th October 2017.
